So we ask, as we endeavour to build this sacred space, that you free up the resources needed, that time and resources would not be drawn from other places of ministry and that your name would be glorified.

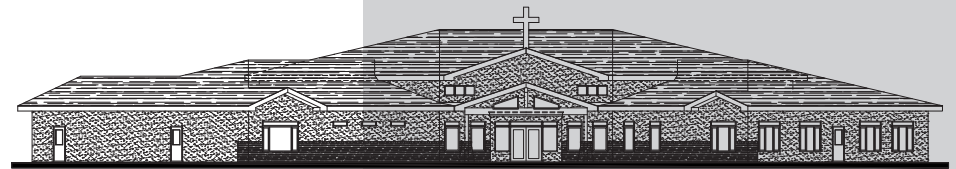
We ask for a debt free building, on your timeline. Make this a short season of paying for a building.

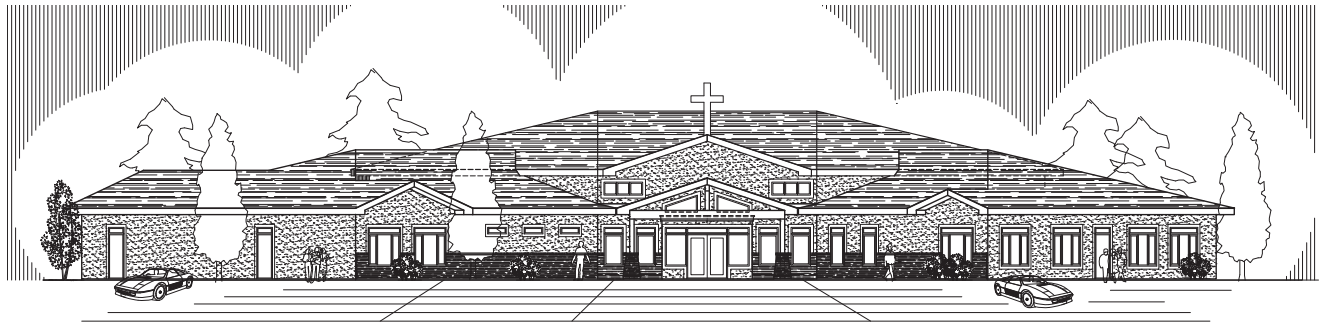

The Project

A home for the congregation of Resurrection Lutheran Brethren Church is about to become a reality.

The ministry of our church needs a home base that is suited to our needs for ministry.

The building will provide a consistent place for worship, discipleship, and fellowship.

It will be a tool in proclaiming the gospel and building up the body of Christ.

As a neighborhood facility, it can be offered for use to the community.

The Build

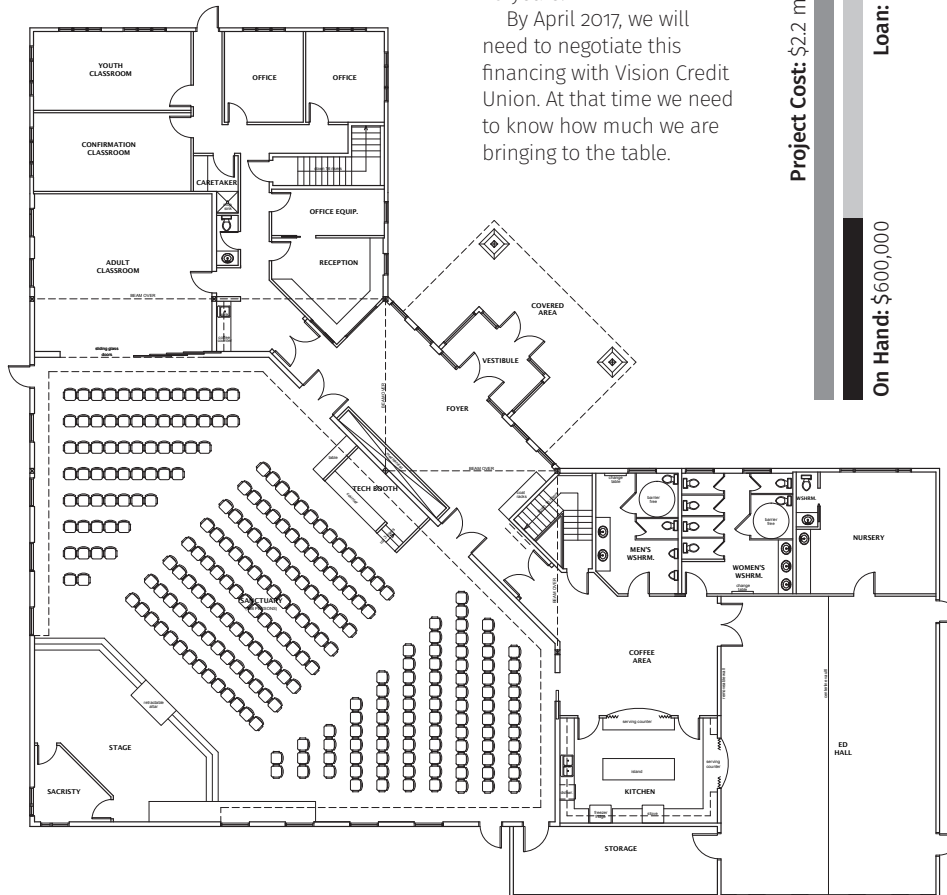
The plan is to begin in the spring of 2017 with Geoff Semmens as project manager. The building will be situated on the property at the corner of Parkview and Enevold Drives.

Financing

The cost is projected to be \$2.2 million for the basic building. About \$600,000 is currently on hand.

There is a potential for \$1.6 million as a loan from Vision Credit Union, to be paid off over the period of 20 years.

By April 2017, we will need to negotiate this financing with Vision Credit Union. At that time we need to know how much we are bringing to the table.

Ways You Can Contribute

ONE TIME DONATION
